


#### Notes on wireless LAN

- This product is designed for indoor use 164'/50 m (may vary on the communication speed or environmental condition) or less away from an access point. Keep it at an appropriately close distance.
- · Check if masking is found or not. Communications across walls or between floors are generally deteriorated. Arrange appropriate installment.
- · Radio wave interference may occur if any radiowave emitting equipment (i.e. microwave) is found near the product and its radiowave is in the same frequency band as the radiowave used by a wireless LAN. Keep the product away from those radio wave interference sources as much as possible.







# Preparing the Toner Cartridges



- 2. Remove the packing materials from the toner cartridge, and install the toner cartridge.
- Remove the packing material. Remove the toner cartridge. Remove the packing material. Shake five to six times. Remove the tab. Place the toner cartridge on a flat surface, and remove the 6 Pull the sealing tape completely out. The full length of the sealing tape is approximately 20 in. (50 cm).



Fit the protrusions on both sides of the toner cartridge into the guides located on both sides of the machine, and slide the toner cartridge into the machine until the toner cartridge comes to rest and is held against the back of the machine.





# Turning On the Machine and Specifying the Initial Settings

## 1. Turn ON the machine.

- When turning ON the machine for the first time after installation. it may output a piece of blank paper. This is not a failure.
- The machine enters the Sleep mode to conserver energy when you do not operate the machine for a certain period of time. To cancel the Sleep mode, press the [10] (Energy Saver) key on the operation panel.

- Use a Category 5 or higher twisted pair cable for the LAN.

## **Explanation of Terminology**

· LAN (Local Area Network)

It is a system that enables the sharing of information by connecting multiple devices such as computers that are within a limited area, such as a single room or inside the same building, using cables or wireless communication (radio waves).

Wireless LAN

It is a network that connects multiple devices using wireless communication (radio waves) without using cables. Generally, it connects to the network using a relay device called a wireless LAN router or access point.





#### **About obtaining the IP address automatically (AutoIP)**

<DHCP> or <Auto IP> is enabled in the default setting.

Even if you do not set the IP address manually, this machine can obtain it automatically.

- Even if you do not have a dedicated device such as a DHCP server, the IP address is obtained automatically.
- The <DHCP> setting is prioritized over <Auto IP>.

If a fixed IP address is set as the IP address of the computer, set the fixed IP address also for this machine manually.

### If the IP address of the machine is changed

When the machine and computer are on the same subnet, the connection is maintained.


# How to display the Help screen


# Connecting a USB Cable (For Macintosh)

# If You Want to Uninstall the Installed Software

If you do not need the printer driver, fax driver, scanner driver, or MF Toolbox, you can uninstall them with the following procedure.

# 1. Confirm the following points.

- You must have administrative privileges on the computer
- You should have the installation software (in case you want to re-install the drivers)
- You have closed all applications on your computer

## 2. Delete the software.

\* If your machine is connected to a computer via the WSD network, you may not uninstall the drivers or software following the procedures below. Refer to "Uninstalling the Software" in the e-Manual to install MF Drivers.


