You can use Application Library to perform a variety of convenient functions, simply by pressing a button on the Home screen.

You can combine functions to suit different circumstances and purposes, and improve the efficiency of various operations.

Using Cloud Services to Quickly Share and Print Data

You can use [Cloud Apps] to send or save scanned data to a linked cloud service, and directly print files stored in a cloud service. You can share or print data with a one-touch operation, without using a computer.

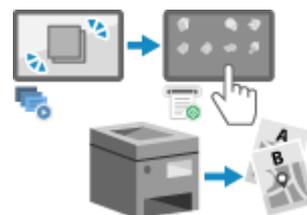

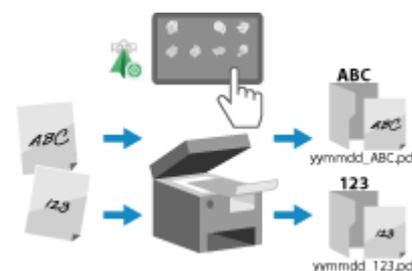

You can use [Name and Scan] to assign file names to scanned data according to rules that you specify, and store the data in specified folders.

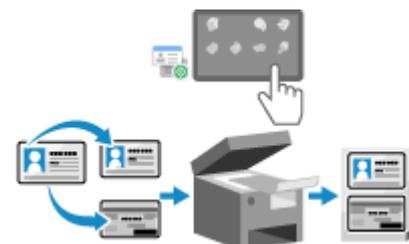

You can use [ID Card Copy (Simple)] to copy both sides of an ID card such as a driver's license or insurance card on one side of a sheet of paper, with settings that you register in advance. You can create different buttons with the appropriate settings for each type of ID.

Various Copying

You can use the applications below to perform various copy operations with a single touch of a button.

	<p>[ID Card Copy (Simple)] Copy ID cards according to the number of copies and image quality settings that are specified in advance. ▶ Copying ID Cards with Prescribed Settings(P. 32)</p>
	<p>[Copy (Enhance Text)] Copy with density settings that are specified in advance. By specifying density settings that suit frequently used originals, you can save the trouble of configuring the settings each time you perform copying. ▶ Copying with Density Settings Specified in Advance(P. 33)</p>
	<p>[Copy (Eco)] Specify a combination of 2-sided copying and N on 1 copying, and perform the combination with a one-touch operation. You can save paper by using this application for large copy jobs. ▶ Copying with Settings That Save Paper and Toner(P. 34)</p>
	<p>[Copy (BleedReduce)] Reduce the amount of bleed-through (phenomenon in which text or images on the back side of the original are visible in the copy) when you perform copying. This application is useful when the original consists of thin paper. ▶ Reducing Bleed-Through When Copying(P. 35)</p>

	<p>[Standby Slide from Server] Register any text or image stored on a server as a slide, and display it on the control panel like a screen saver. You can also register multiple slides and display them in a specified order. ▶ Displaying Text or an Image from a Server on the Control Panel(P. 38)</p>
	<p>[Language] Switch the display language with a one-touch operation. Each time you press the button, the display language of the control panel switches in the order that the display languages were registered. ▶ Switching the Display Language(P. 41)</p>

Use the dedicated management screen in Remote UI to register and configure applications. To use Remote UI, access the IP address of the machine from a web browser on a computer. Administrator privileges are required in order to access the management screen.

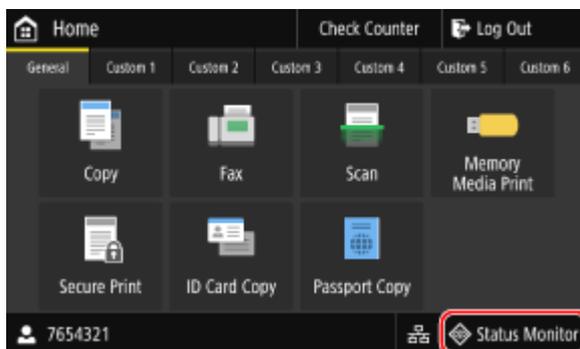

Checking the IP Address of the Machine

- 1** On the [Home] screen of the control panel or other location, press [Status Monitor].



- 2** Check the IP address.



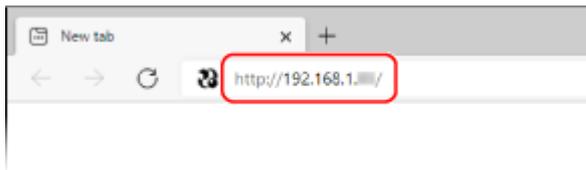
NOTE

- If the IP address is not displayed at the bottom of the [Status Monitor] screen, press [Network Information] ▶ [IPv4] to check the IP address.

Starting Remote UI

1 From a web browser on a computer, access the following URL.

http://<IP address of the machine>/



⇒ The Remote UI login screen appears.

If Remote UI communication is encrypted, a warning message about the security certificate may appear. If there are no problems with the certificate or TLS settings, you can continue operations.

When entering an IPv6 address, enclose the IP address in brackets [].

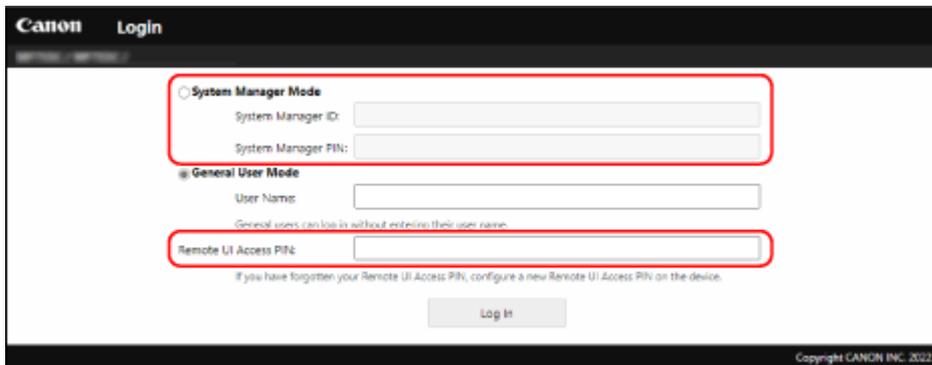

2 Enter the items required to log in with System Manager Mode.

■ If the Screen for Selecting [System Manager Mode] Appears

Select [System Manager Mode], and enter the required items according to the setting status.



When the System Manager ID Is Set

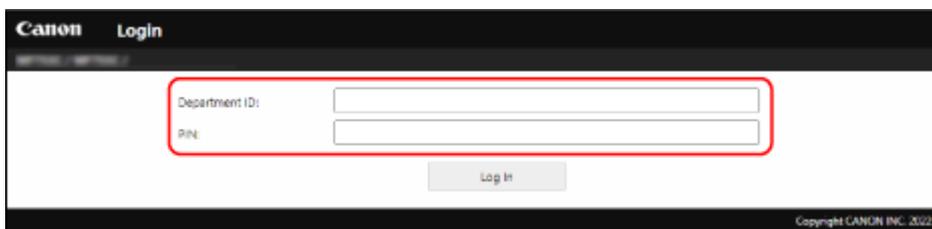
Enter the System Manager ID and System Manager PIN.

When the Remote UI Access PIN Is Set

Enter the Remote UI Access PIN.

■ If the Screen for Entering the Department ID Appears

Enter the Department ID and PIN.



When the System Manager ID Is Set

Enter the System Manager ID and System Manager PIN.

When the System Manager ID Is Not Set

Enter any number for the Department ID.

3 Click [Log In].

⇒ The Portal page of Remote UI appears.

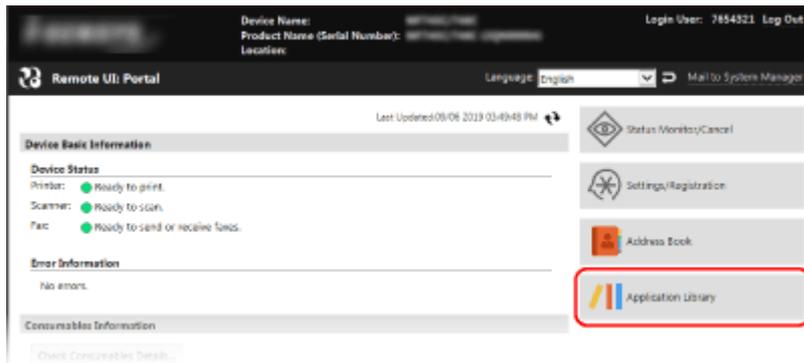

Opening the [Application Management] Screen

A list of available applications is displayed on the [Application Management] screen. ▶ **Application List(P. 4)**

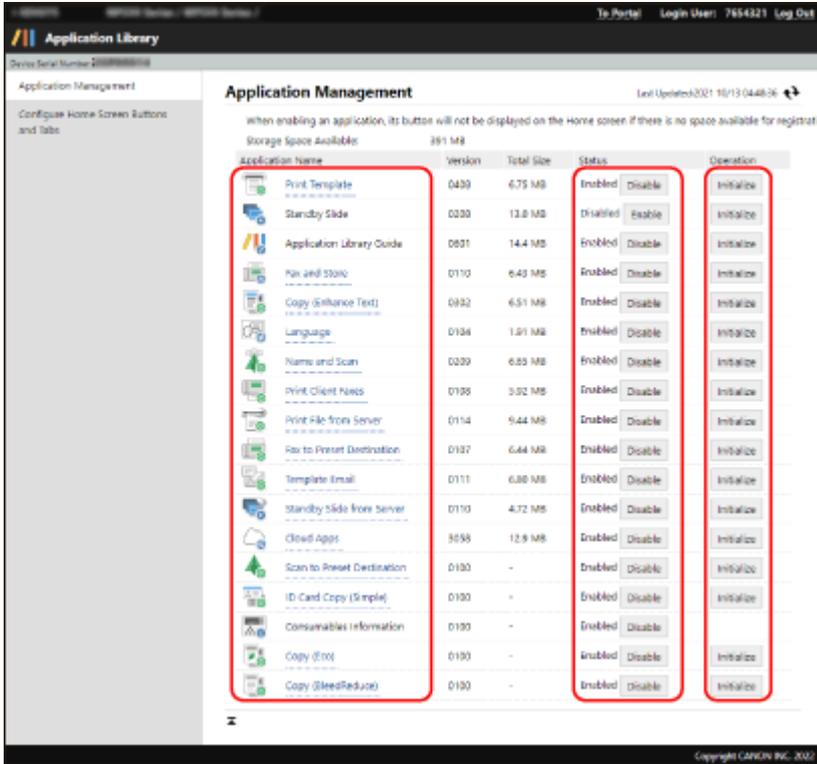

This screen appears when you click [Application Library] on the Portal page of Remote UI. You can enable or disable each application and change the settings.



[Application Name]

Displays a list of applications that are installed on the machine. When you click a link for an application in the [Application Name] list, the setting screen for that application appears.

[Status]

Enables or disables each application. When an application is disabled, the button on the [Home] of the control panel is hidden.

[Operation]

When you click [Initialize] for an application, the initial settings of the application are restored and the registered button is deleted.

Using Applications

To use an application, press the button for the application on the [Home] screen of the control panel. You may need to register and configure the buttons for some applications. You can also register multiple buttons with different settings, and use them according to the circumstances or purpose.

Applications with Buttons to Register Before Use

By default, the buttons for the applications listed below are displayed on the [Home] screen of the control panel. However, you need to register the buttons in order to use them. Select each application that you want to use from the list, and register the buttons. The settings to configure when registering the buttons vary depending on the application.

Linking to Cloud Service

You can use "Cloud Apps" to send or save scanned data to a linked cloud service. You can also print files stored in a cloud service.

This application is only available with machine models provided with the scan function. The maximum file size that can be sent or saved is 30 MB.

To use this function, register the scan button or print button on the [Home] screen of the control panel by following the procedure below.

Required Preparations

- Prepare the information required for authorization of the linked cloud service, and have it on hand. For details on the information required for authorization, see the website of the cloud service.

1 In Remote UI, access the management screen. ▶ Accessing the Management Screen(P. 7)

2 On the [Application Management] screen, click [Cloud Apps].

⇒ The [Cloud Apps] screen appears.

3 Click [Register New Button].

⇒ The [Register New Button] screen appears.

4 Enter the button names.

Enter names for the button group, scan button, and print button.

The name for the button group is used to manage the scan button and print button together.

■ To Display the Confirmation Screen When the Button Is Pressed

Select the [Display Confirmation Screen Before Operation] checkbox.

5 Select the cloud service to be linked.

6 Configure the scan and print settings.

▶ Scan Settings(P. 43)

▶ Print Settings(P. 42)

7 Click [Authorize].

⇒ The cloud service authorization screen appears.

8 Authorize the cloud service according to the instructions on the screen.

⇒ When authorization is completed, the [Cloud Apps] screen in Remote UI reappears.

The button is added to the [Home] screen of the control panel.

The authorization procedure varies depending on the cloud service.

9 Log out from Remote UI.

NOTE

Authorization of Cloud Service

- The button is added even if cloud service authorization fails. To perform authorization again, click [Reauthorize] on the [Cloud Apps] screen.
- Some cloud services have an expiration date for authorization. If the expiration date has passed, click [Reauthorize] on the [Cloud Apps] screen to perform authorization again.
- Set the date and time of the machine accurately. Otherwise, an error may occur with the cloud service authorization. For details on the date and time settings, see the "User's Guide" for your model at the online manual site.

Printing Specific Files

You can use "Print Template" to easily print images and documents that are specified in advance, when they are needed.

Specify files that are saved on a computer. You can only specify files in JPEG or PDF format, and the maximum total file size is 48 MB.

To specify files on a server or website, use "Print File from Server." [▶Printing Specific Files from a Server\(P. 18\)](#)

To use this function, register the button on the [Home] screen of the control panel by following the procedure below.

1 In Remote UI, access the management screen. [▶Accessing the Management Screen\(P. 7\)](#)

2 On the [Application Management] screen, click [Print Template].

⇒ The [Print Template] screen appears.

3 Click [Register New Button].

⇒ The [Register New Button] screen appears.

4 Enter the button name.

■To Display the Confirmation Screen When the Button Is Pressed

Select the [Display Confirmation Screen Before Operation] checkbox.

5 For [File Path], click [Browse] and specify the file to register.

6 Configure the print settings. [▶Print Settings\(P. 42\)](#)

7 Click [OK].

⇒ The button is added to the [Home] screen of the control panel.

8 Log out from Remote UI.

Printing Specific Files from a Server

You can use "Print File from Server" to print images from a server or website that is specified in advance. You can print all of the files in the specified folder when you press the button, or configure settings to periodically print the registered files automatically.

You can only print files in JPEG or PDF format. For PDF files, the maximum file size is 250 MB.

To use this function, register the button on the [Home] screen of the control panel by following the procedure below.

Required Preparations

- Prepare the following information and have it on hand.
 - File path, folder path, or URL to be specified
 - User name and password used for accessing the file or folder to be specified (if Restrict Access is set)

1 In Remote UI, access the management screen. Accessing the Management Screen(P. 7)

2 On the [Application Management] screen, click [Print File from Server].

⇒ The [Print File from Server] screen appears.

3 Click [Register New Button].

⇒ The [Register New Button] screen appears.

4 Enter the button name.

■ To Display the Confirmation Screen When the Button Is Pressed

Select the [Display Confirmation Screen Before Operation] checkbox.

5 Enter the location of the file or folder that you want to register.

Specify the path or URL.

■ To Specify the Path

In [File/Folder], select [Specify File Path] and enter the path of the file or folder. Use "\" as a separator.

■ To Specify the URL

In [File/Folder], select [Specify URL] and enter the URL of the file or folder.

6 Enter the user name and password, as needed.

- If Restrict Access is enabled for the folder or server, enter the user name and password used for accessing the folder or server.
- To enter a password, select the [Set/Change Password] checkbox, and then enter the password.
- You can click [Check Connection] to check whether the machine can connect to the specified file or folder.

7 Configure the print settings. ▶ **Print Settings(P. 42)**

To Print Periodically

Select the [Configure Print Schedule] checkbox, and set the days and times to print.

* When you use Department ID Management, uniFLOW Online, or uniFLOW Online Express, periodic printing is disabled even if the schedule is set.

8 Click [OK].

⇒ The button is added to the [Home] screen of the control panel.

9 Log out from Remote UI.

NOTE

- If the folder contains 11 or more files when you press the button, 10 files will be printed in reverse chronological order of the last update.

Sending or Saving Scanned Data to a Specific Destination

You can use "Scan to Preset Destination" to send or save scanned data to destinations that are specified in advance.

To use this function, register the button on the [Home] screen of the control panel by following the procedure below.

4 Enter the button name.

■ To Display the Confirmation Screen When the Button Is Pressed

Select the [Display Confirmation Screen Before Operation] checkbox.

5 Select [Send Category], and click [Switch].

6 Configure the TX settings.

The setting items vary depending on the send category selected in Step 5.

■ When [E-Mail] Is Selected in [Send Category]

1 Enter an e-mail address in [Destination], and then click [Add].

⇒ The e-mail address is added to [Destination List].

2 Add destinations as needed.

- For Cc/Bcc destinations, click [Select from Address Book] and specify the destinations.
- To change the e-mail address type (To/Cc/Bcc), click [Switch to To/Cc/Bcc].
- You can click [Delete] to delete the selected e-mail address from the list.

3 Enter a subject and message for the e-mail.

4 Configure the e-mail information.

[Reply-to]

Select an e-mail address (Reply-To) from the Address Book to be used as the address that e-mail recipients reply to.

If no e-mail address is selected here, the e-mail address of the machine is used as the Reply-To e-mail address.

[Priority]

Select the priority level.

■ When [File] Is Selected in [Send Category]

1 In [Destination], click [Select from Address Book].

⇒ The [Select from Address Book] screen appears.

2 Select the destination, and click [OK].

⇒ The [Register New Button] screen reappears.

■ When [USB Memory] Is Selected in [Send Category]

This step is not required. Proceed to Step 7.

7 Configure the scan settings. ▶ **Scan Settings(P. 43)**

8 Click [OK].

⇒ The button is added to the [Home] screen of the control panel.

9 Log out from Remote UI.

NOTE

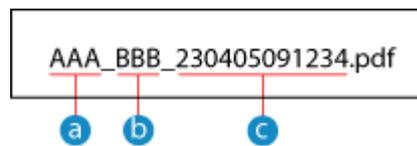

9 Configure the file name settings as needed.

Specify the items to be added to the file name, as well as the order and format of the items.

- To add the ID that was configured in Step 8, select the [Add ID to File Name] checkbox.
- Select the [Use Separators in File Name] checkbox if you want to insert "_" as a separator between the text, ID, and date and time in the file name.
- In [Display Order in File Name], specify the order of the text, ID, and date and time in the file name.

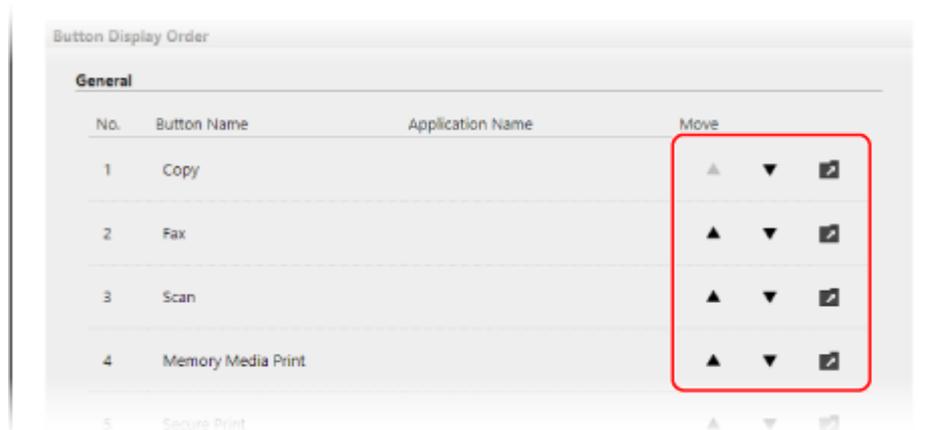
