

Version de micrologiciel 1.1 pour Moniteur vidéo DP-V3120

Détails des changements apportés au micrologiciel

Ce micrologiciel (version 1.1) comprend les fonctions supplémentaires et les améliorations de performance suivantes.

1. Les fichiers LUT au format *.cube* peuvent à présent être directement importés dans l'unité d'affichage.
2. Les LUT 1D peuvent à présent être importés dans la LUT utilisateur. La plage du signal vidéo peut également à présent être convertie avant ou après le traitement de la LUT utilisateur (LUT 1D/LUT 3D).
3. Lors de la lecture d'une vidéo Canon Log à partir d'une caméra de cinéma EOS*¹ via SDI ou HDMI, l'unité d'affichage peut à présent détecter et afficher automatiquement la plage de couleurs (pleine ou limitée) qui correspond à la plage de sortie vidéo (plage complète ou plage étroite).
4. Ajout de deux LUT à « CDL/User LUT » qui convertissent les vidéos prises avec des caméras cinéma RED numériques en HDR (PQ) et SDR.
5. Ajout d'une fonction à « Pixel Value Check » qui indique les valeurs de chromaticité xy d'un pixel spécifié ainsi que sa position de coordonnées sur le diagramme de chromaticité².
6. Ajout d'une fonction à « Compare View » afin de comparer différentes valeurs de luminance côte à côte : par exemple, 2 000 cd/m² par rapport à 1 000 cd/m².
7. Ajout de « Peak Range » à « Range Check » qui met en évidence les zones de plage à haute luminance définies avec le réglage normal « Over Range ».
8. Les erreurs détectées par « Signal Monitoring » peuvent à présent être exportées sous forme de journal sur des clés USB ou d'autres périphériques de stockage externes. Le journal d'erreurs est à présent conservé même après un cycle de mise sous/hors tension.
9. Changement de la plage des réglages de la taille de la zone (largeur et hauteur) et de la position d'affichage de la zone (horizontal et vertical) pour le « Safety Zone Marker ». Ajout également de « Box (Mask) » aux contours de la zone.
10. Ajout de « Area Marker 2 ». Il est maintenant possible de régler deux marqueurs de zone.
11. Ajout de 80% (UHD) – 95% (UHD) au réglage d'intervalle « Grid Marker ».
12. Ajout de paramètres pour régler l'ordre et la position de l'affichage du canal sur « Audio Level Meter ».
13. Il est maintenant possible de sélectionner et d'afficher 16:9 et 4:3 pour faire correspondre le rapport d'aspect lors de l'affichage du signal vidéo SD-SDI. La détection automatique et l'affichage avec l'ID du Payload sont à présent également possibles.
14. L'unité peut à présent détecter et basculer automatiquement l'affichage lorsque le signal d'entrée commute entre SD-SDI et HD-SDI.
15. Ajout de « Marker 1/2/3 », « Monochrome », « Blue Only », « Red Off », « Green Off » et « Blue Off » aux fonctions pouvant être sauvegardées sous chaque broche GPI sous « Remote(GPI) ».
16. Ajout de 10 % et 5 % aux options d'échelle d'affichage pour les graphiques de rapport HDR/SDR sur « Frame luminance Monitor ».
17. Amélioration de la convivialité du navigateur Web, y compris le déplacement de la position du vérificateur de valeur de pixel, en cliquant ou en touchant la fenêtre de visualisation pendant le fonctionnement à distance via Wi-Fi ou LAN et en permettant l'entrée directe de valeurs pour la

barre de réglage dans la fenêtre de commande.

18. Ajout d'un réglage permettant de conserver le nom des boutons de l'unité allumé en permanence.
19. Modification du comportement lors de l'utilisation du système gamma automatique pour Hybrid Log-Gamma (HLG).
20. Ajout d'une fonction d'économie d'énergie.
21. Autres améliorations de la convivialité et de l'affichage.

C700 / C700 GS / C700 FF (réglages de la LUT utilisateur et de SDI uniquement)

- *2 Uniquement pour la gamme de couleurs BT.2020 et une courbe gamma de 1,0, 2,2, 2,35, 2,4, 2,6, PQ ou HLG (sauf HLG RVB).

Vérifiez la version de micrologiciel sur votre écran. S'il s'agit de la version 1.0 ou antérieure, vous devrez procéder à la mise à niveau vers la version 1.1. Aucune action n'est nécessaire si le micrologiciel de l'écran est à la version 1.1.

Préparatifs pour mettre à jour le micrologiciel

Il est recommandé d'exporter les réglages actuels avant d'essayer de mettre à jour le micrologiciel. Une fois que le micrologiciel a été mis à jour, les réglages peuvent être réimportés sur l'écran.

Le dossier téléchargé contient le nouveau micrologiciel. (Nom de fichier : « update_dpv3120.rom », taille de fichier : 23,960,049 octets) Il contient également la documentation pour la procédure de mise à jour du micrologiciel (fichier PDF multilingue dans les langues suivantes : japonais, anglais, français, allemand et chinois (caractères simplifiés)). Avant de commencer la mise à jour du micrologiciel, veuillez lire la documentation s'y rapportant.

Les éléments suivants sont nécessaires pour mettre à jour le micrologiciel :

1. Écran
2. Ordinateur personnel
3. Clé USB (FAT16 ou FAT32)
4. Micrologiciel (Le fichier téléchargé)
